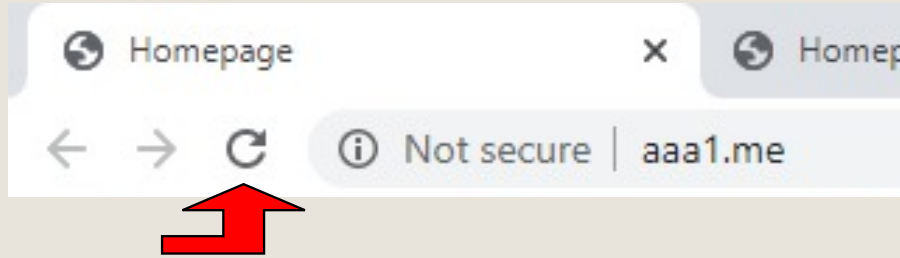


How to clear my browser cache

Sometimes website “changes” do not show because Internet browsers use “caching” to store web pages. The first to try is refresh the page. In the left top of your browser click The small circled arrow. If that does Not work you can do the next step.



The Browser stores a copy of visited pages on the hard drive and will use that copy to render when you next time visit that same site. The browser loads up the one on your hard drive rather than re-downloading the site from the Internet. If changes were made after you had visited the site, the changes will not show unless you clean the browser cache. To do so follow instructions below: You can first try if it works if you refresh the page.

When the history of your browser is cleared and the website will show the way it is on the Internet and not what is on your hard Drive. Interested in Flash Drives ask us about it

You need to have the browser you are using open: Hold Shift + Ctrl. then on the right site of your keyboard tap “Del” or “Delete” on some key-boards. On the pop-up window check the items you like to clear. On the bottom of the window you click to delete or clear these items.



The location of the delete button is different on each type of keyboard
